Serve chilled with freshly shucked oysters, crayfish or lemon garnished fish dishes simply enjoy on a warm summer evening.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2016 growing season was one of the best in the decade: a dry start, long and drawn out ripening season with a slightly larger than average crop. This was helped out by healthy rainfall in February as the grapes reached maturity and ensured that they were of excellent quality right to the finish line.

WINEMAKING

Crisp fruit, 70% French clone 95 giving rich pear and apple, 30% American clone I10 with fresh melon and citrus acid backbone. Stainless steel tank fermentation.
