Variety:	Pinot Noir
Region:	Adelaide Hills

Colour:	Light cherry
Bouquet:	Delicate raspberry and strawberry red berry fruit
Palate:	A light and crisp Rosé. Light with abundant wild strawberry and raspberry fruit flavours. Delicate fruit flavours lead to an elegant finish.

FOOD MATCHES

Serve chilled with a Thai larp salad, use the refreshing fruit flavours to tame the heat of your favourite curry, or simply enjoy with friends on a warm summer evening.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2017 vintage was full of challenges: ever changing and cool weather conditions delayed ripening dates on all varieties. This resulted in a longer hang-time for fruit, which ensured the flavour and aroma concentrations were exceptional. Above average winter rainfall left the dams full and soil moisture levels were stable to ensure the best conditions for quality fruit and consistent moderate / cool weather conditions maintained optimum vine balance and excellent colour, flavours and aromas in the grapes.

WINEMAKING

Handpicked from five separate parcels and blended to achieve optimum results. Stainless steel tank fermentation.
